

CERAMICS

Ceramics are composed mainly of fired clay. The special production process, which includes heating the slabs at a temperature of 1200 degrees, ensures that your worktop has exceptionally good properties. We recommend the following when caring for the countertop:

Daily care

The countertop can be wiped down with a mixture of water and dish soap or some other mild soap.

Cleaning stains

Stubborn stains can be treated with a small amount of Cif Cream or organic vinegar. Be sure to rinse with plenty of clean water.

- Precautionary measures with use
- Do not cut directly on the surface with a ceramic knife. It is manufactured from a material with the same hardness as the worktop.
- Avoid contact with very acidic or alkaline cleaning agents such as, for example, drain unblockers and oven cleaners (pH value <2 or >12).
- Prevent a shock effect by placing extreme heat on the countertop. Always use a trivet under hot pans.

• Ceramics have a very compact mass, which means that they are just as sensitive as other stone materials to damage due to impact. Be careful not to bump hard objects (pans, for example) against the edge of the countertop. This could lead to irreparable damage.

- Never sit or stand on the countertop.



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
